

5 Steps to Protecting your Art Collection



Trucks should have dual drivers, Check if the art shippers will use **third parties and** temporary storage locations during transit



Step 2: Display & Maintenance Creating a Safe Environment at Home

> Temperature: 21 - 24°C Use proper artificial lighting Humidity: 45 - 55% and do not display artwork directly under light or sunlight * * * * * * Avoid displaying artwork where there is busy human traffic Mount fragile artwork securely



Step 3: Storage Consider these factors when selecting a storage facility


Step 4: Monitoring **Updated Values**

Ensure the valuation of the art collection is up-to-date to avoid inadequate insurance coverage in the event of a claim

Step 5: Database Keeping an inventory



Create and **regularly update** a database of the collection

Store **duplicates** (in hard and soft copies) of database, invoices, appraisals and authenticity certificates in different locations



Include full descriptions of all artworks in the database
